


In Maths we will be:

- Recognising and create repeating patterns with numbers, objects and shapes.
- Identifying odd and even numbers linked to counting in twos from 0 and 1.
- Recognising, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity (including measure).
- Recognising, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.
- Comparing and describing capacity/volume (for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half-full, quarter).
- Measuring and beginning to record capacity and volume using non-standard and then standard units (litres and ml)
- Recognising and knowing the value of different denominations of coins and notes.
- Solving simple one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems, such as $7 = \square - 9$.
- Recognising and using language relating to dates, including days of the week, weeks, months and years.
- Sequencing events in chronological order using language such as: before and after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening
- Measuring and begin to record time (hours, minutes, seconds).

SANTA'S WORKSHOP



Over this next half term, we will be exploring all about the wonderful world of toys. We will be learning about the materials different toys are made out and why each material is used. We will also be exploring toys from different places around the world and how they are different to the toys we may play with.

We will also be exploring the Arctic and the animals that live there and how they survive such cold weather.



In English we will be:

- Responding in a role as a character and making inferences about how they are feeling.
- Able to make a prediction about a text.
- Re-telling a story orally.
- Learning and recognising features of a simple narrative text.
- Asking questions related to who, what, where, when and why to demonstrate understanding of a text.
- Looking at the differences between fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Learning the key features of an information text.
- Gathering information from a range of sources, asking and answering questions e.g. film, ICT texts, books and information exchanged with others.
- Using capital letters and full stops throughout their writing
- Learning when to use question marks within their writing.



Lead Subjects

Science: This half term we will be learning all about the different materials toys are made from. We will be learning to distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. We will be looking at different toys and deciding what they are made of and how we know. We will be focusing on everyday materials such as; wood, plastic, glass, metal and rock. We will be describing the simple physical properties of these materials and then we will be comparing and grouping these materials together.

Geography: During this half term we will be exploring all about the Arctic. We will investigate why the Arctic is so cold and how the weather there is different to the weather in the UK. We will also be looking at toys from around the world and how these may be different to the toys we like to play with here.

P.E : will be on a Friday afternoon. This term we will be continuing our work on fundamentals skills such as; throwing catching, running, jumping and balancing.



RE: this half term we will be starting to explore different religions. We will start by learning about Islam, we will discuss what religion means and why people believe different things. Children will also be learning all about Christmas and why we give and receive gifts at this special time of year.

PSHE: over this half term we will be focusing on ensuring we are healthy and safe. We will be learning about what we must do to keep our bodies healthy for example; what food we should be eating and why it is important to keep our bodies clean.

Art: In our Art lessons this half term we will be making a beautiful piece of work based on Arctic animals. We will be learning about primary colours and what colours we can mix to create new colours. We will also be using our cutting skills to create our 3D artwork.

History: In our history lessons we will be learning about changes within living memory. We will be exploring different toys from the past and how they are similar or different to our favourite toys.
